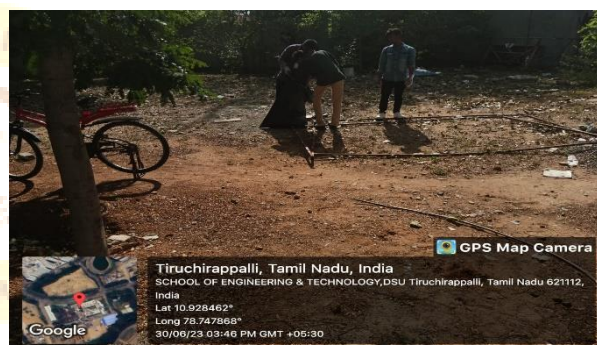

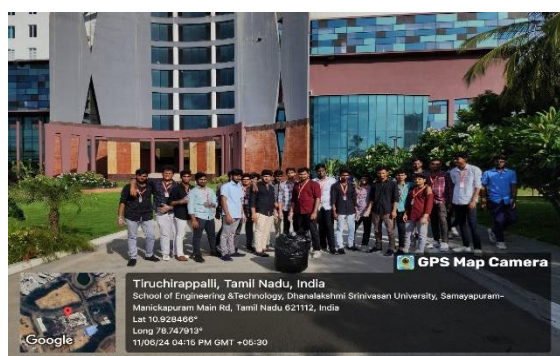

Waste Water Management

With rising water scarcity and increasing water prices, wastewater treatment has the potential to mature as a profitable intervention. Instead of treating it as a waste to be disposed of, wastewater should be considered a resource for recycling and reuse. Wastewater collected from Dhanalakshmi Srinivasan University hostels are treated with Sewage Treatment Plant (STP), is being used as important source of irrigation water as well as source of nutrients for crop production

Composting is a natural process that turns organic matter into nutrient-rich fertilizer that can be used in gardening, agriculture, and horticulture. It can be done with kitchen waste and agriculture waste. Kitchen waste, including vegetable peels, fruit scraps, coffee grounds, and eggshells are collected from DSU hostel and agricultural waste including crop residues are used for composting. Utilizing kitchen waste in agriculture not only addresses the issue of waste management but also enhances soil health and promotes a circular economy. This gradually gaining momentum, driven by increasing awareness of environmental sustainability and the need for organic farming practices.

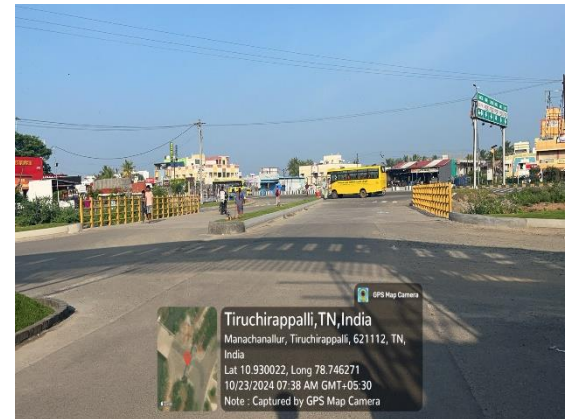

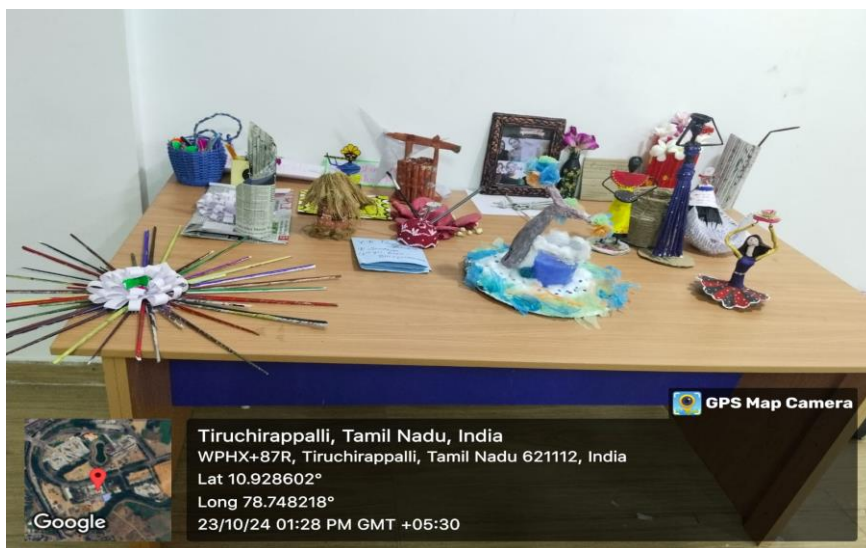

Road construction completed to have water resistant and moisture damage protection road near staff quarters inside the campus



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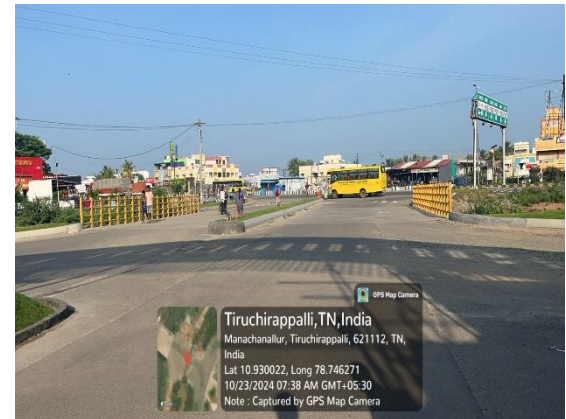

For utilizing the space efficiently, the unused part of Seminar Hall of school of engineering and Technology is converted into department.



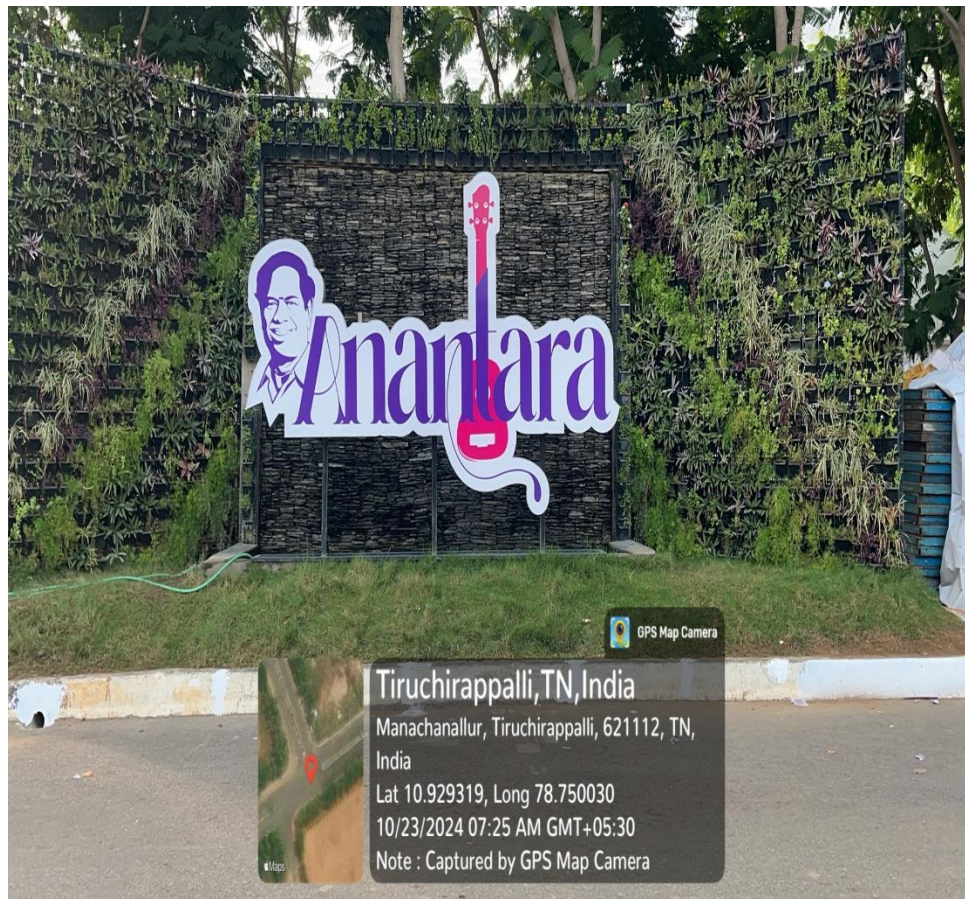

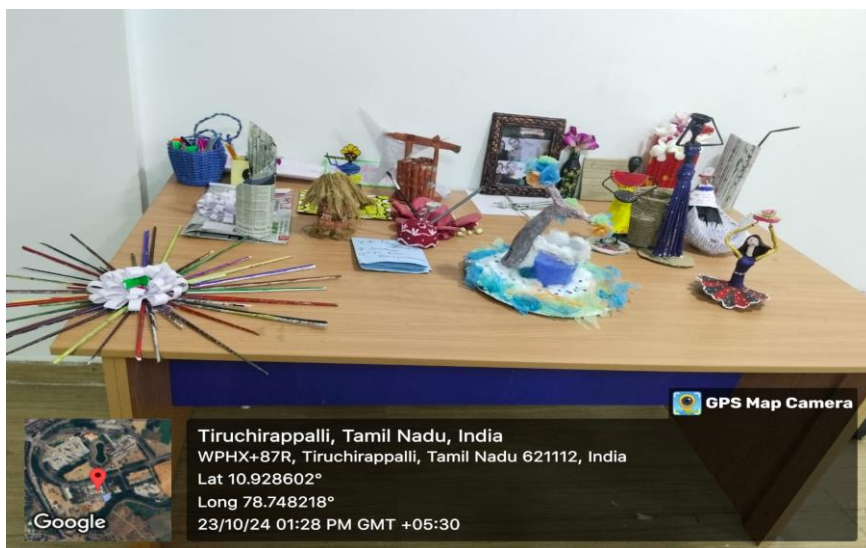


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10. Waste to Wealth - Arts from Waste at DSU, Trichy

As a part of environment friendly practices, we maintained the pond with protection wall and greenish atmosphere in its surrounding area which is consistently maintained in a clean and daily basis.



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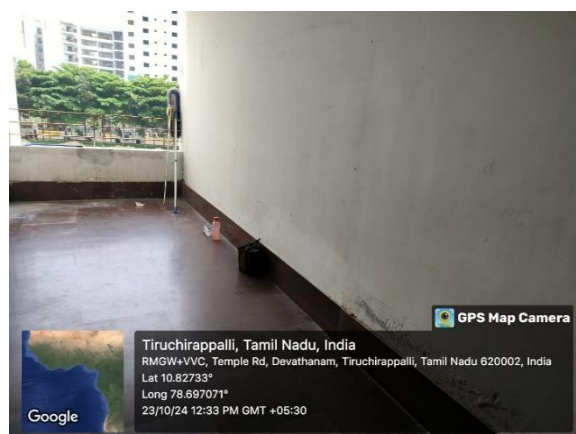
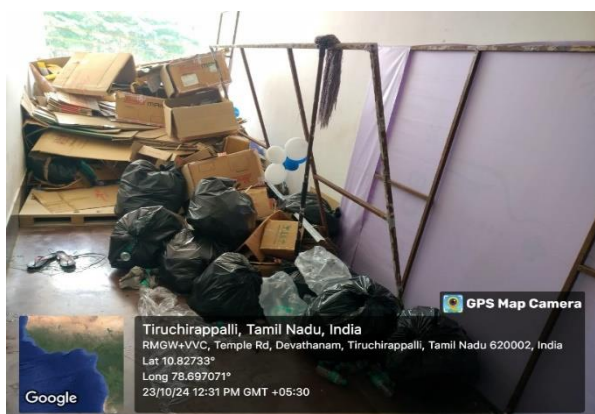
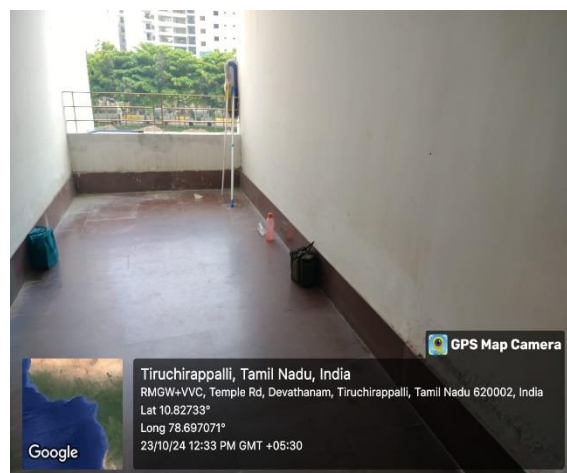
